



## Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

As part of our product stewardship and regulatory compliance efforts, we continue to monitor regulatory, safety, health and environmental impacts of using our products.

According to Proposition 65, State of California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to California [and others doing business in the state of California] about significant exposures to chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm.


Most products manufactured by International Wire Group (IWG) do not contain substances regulated by California Proposition 65 in concentrations resulting in exposures above the safe levels determined by the OEHHA. As such, these products are not required to have the Proposition 65 warning labels.
